

2013 Canada Games Coach Identification Program

Application

The intention of this program is to identify current and future high performance coaches, nurture their development and facilitate the development of athletes who are committed to representing Nova Scotia at the 2013 Canada Games.

Athletics Nova Scotia is seeking coaches interested in being a part of the 2013 Canada Games Coaching Team. We are seeking the following applicants:

- 4 coaches with a specialization in throwing events
- 4 coaches with a specialization in jumping events
- 4 coaches with a specialization in sprinting events
- 4 coaches with a specialization in middle / long distance events

The responsibilities of these coaches for the 2010/11 season include:

- Assisting in the development of a Canada Games athlete identification program (round table meeting at the Provincial Championship Meet – Friday, July 9th evening)
- Coaching at the 2010/11 athlete identification camps (one day testing events in October and April in several areas around the province).
- Mentoring coaches and athletes around the province

If chosen to be a part of our coach identification program you will receive the following benefits during the 2010/11 season:

- An Honorarium of \$250
- Be a part of a high performance coaching group
- Be a mentor to other coaches around the province
- Be a candidate for the 2013 Canada Games Coaching team.

If a coach is not able to fulfill their commitments – a similar recruitment process will be adhered to for finding a replacement. This identified group will be assessed by the ANS board of directors on an annual basis until the 2013 games.

To be eligible to be an identified coach for the 2013 Canada Games, you must have the following requirements.

1. **You must be a member of Athletics Nova Scotia.**
2. **You must have a minimum of level 1 coaching certification**
3. **You must be actively involved in coaching in Nova Scotia**
4. **You must be willing to assist in the Athlete ID camps scheduled for Fall 2010 and Spring 2011**
5. **You must be committed to achieving a level 3 certification before the 2013 Canada Games**
6. **Application deadline: June 20th, 2010**

A selection committee, appointed by the ANS board of directors, will review all applications, identify and recommend a maximum of 16 coaches for ANS board approval.
